

# VIG Hungarian Money Market Investment Fund

## INVESTMENT POLICY OF THE FUND

The Fund's aim is to function as a stable, low-risk form of investment, while providing investors with higher returns than they could expect from bank deposits. In order to ensure liquidity, the Fund intends primarily to hold in its portfolio government bonds and discount treasury bills issued by the Government Debt Management Agency (ÁKK) and bonds issued by the National Bank of Hungary (MNB). The weighted average maturity (WAM) of the assets in the portfolio may not exceed 6 months and the weighted average life (WAL) of the assets may not exceed 12 months. The Fund may hold in its portfolio low-risk debt securities issued by banks and companies, which are expected to provide higher returns than government securities and are denominated primarily in HUF, but also in other currencies. The Fund may also invest to a limited extent in government securities or guaranteed bonds issued by the OECD or a G20 country, or any debt security issued or guaranteed by the central government or a regional or local government or the central bank of any EU Member State, or by the European Union, the European Central Bank or the European Investment Bank. The weighted average maturity (WAM) of the assets in the portfolio may not exceed 6 months and the weighted average life (WAL) of the assets may not exceed 12 months. In addition, the remaining time to maturity of each security is a maximum of 2 years and a maximum of 397 days until the nearest interest-rate determination date. The Fund may also keep its liquid assets in bank deposits. The fund may hold a limited amount of foreign currency assets in its portfolio, but only subject to the full hedging of currency risk.

## MARKET SUMMARY

The performance of bond markets continued to be driven by the Iranian conflict that broke out at the end of February and has been ongoing ever since. Throughout the month, statements by Donald Trump aimed at ending the war repeatedly put downward pressure on oil prices; however, a lasting peace between the two sides has yet to be achieved. The impact of oil price movements has also been visible in the Hungarian bond market. At the same time, post-election euphoria continues to prevail, contributing to a further decline in Hungarian bond yields during May, which are currently in the 5.2%– 5.5% range. Inflation in May significantly surprised the market, as according to the Central Statistical Office year-on-year inflation arrived at 1,8% compared to the 2,2% expected by the market. At its rate-setting meeting at the end of May, the Monetary Council left the policy rate unchanged. However, two weeks before the meeting, the National Bank of Hungary (MNB) significantly reduced the maximum swap point value that could be submitted in its FX swap tender providing euro liquidity, thereby lowering the annualized forint interest rate available through the tender by 50 basis points. The forint weakened somewhat following the announcement but continues to trade in the 350– 360 range against the euro. While discussions in other CEE countries are increasingly focused on the possibility of interest rate hikes, in Hungary the market expects a rate cut in June due to the favorable inflation outlook and the strength of the forint. Geopolitical uncertainty remains elevated, as the outcome of the Iranian war is still far from clear. Short-term yields have declined significantly, and given expectations of monetary easing together with the strong forint, we continue to maintain a positive outlook on the asset class.

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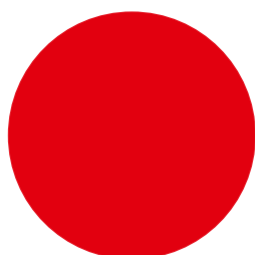

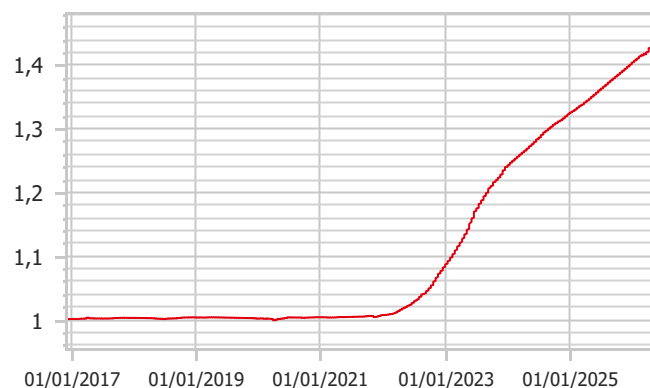
