### INVESTMENT POLICY OF THE FUND

The Fund aims to increase the value of its assets under management and to provide investors with a higher yield than Czech bank deposits and short-term bonds over a period of 1 to 2 years. No individual investor's decisions can be made in the Fund. The Fund Manager selects portfolio elements in accordance with the above principles. When making investment decisions, the tools of fundamental analysis and technical analysis are used, and the current market sentiment is also taken into account. The Fund primarily invests in discount treasury bills issued by the Czech State, sovereign bonds, bonds of quasi-sovereign companies, or bonds or deposit-like instruments issued by the Czech National Bank, the European Central Bank or the central bank of another Member State of the European Union. To a limited extent, the portfolio may include government securities, state-guaranteed bonds, corporate bonds (including those issued by financial institutions) and mortgage bonds with at least investment-grade credit rating. Investments may be made in Czech crowns or, to a limited extent, in other currencies. In the case of assets denominated in a currency other than Czech crowns, the Asset Manager shall strive to fully hedge foreign exchange risks (there cannot be a difference of more than 5% between the currency exposure of the derivative transaction and that of the asset to be hedged).

The Fund may enter into deposit and repo transactions, invest – to a limited extent – in units in collective investment undertakings, and derivatives may as well be used (for the purposes of hedging or building an efficient portfolio).

#### MARKET SUMMARY

The main questionmark for March was 50 or 75bps easing by the Czech National Bank (CNB). Market expectations ran forward especially previously this year, local macro environment would have allowed a larger rate cut, but general macro environment is rather making bond investors cautious. Despite the fat that core market long bond yields increased already close to 50 bps this year (that is comparable to the first disappointment in 1995, which was the perfect playbook for soft landing in modern US history) so valuation and levels of bond yields could be marked as attractive, even more if we taking quite dovish FED during the last meeting into account, however latest macro data, increase in global commodity prices and breaking higher than 4,35% for the US10Yr yield is a rather negative signal for bond ivestors.

In the end, the CNB reduced its two-week repo rate by another 50bp, with two dissenting votes cast in favour of a larger cut (75bp). The vote split provided no surprises. Although inflation returned to the +2.0% Y/Y target, the central bank maintained its hawkish rhetoric, offering a list of upside risks to the inflation outlook and flagging various areas of concern. More interestingly, the movement of the koruna exchange rate was added to the list of inflationary risks, despite different references before. The CNB is expected to continue its rate-cutting cycle in May (most probably by 50bps), when staff will prepare the new macroeconomic forecast. Czech short term bond yields increased by close to 30bps during the month detracting some performance for the fund.


